Choosing the right kind of crane is really crucial for making sure that the material could be moved efficiently and safely to the location it needs to get to in order for the construction process to commence. Normally, truck cranes have 2 different cabs. One cab is for controlling the crane and the other is for driving the truck when the unit is in transport mode. These cranes are very helpful for building locations where a crane is needed in numerous different places for the duration of the build. This is because of the fact that the crane could be driven easily from one place to another. Cranes could also be transported to different construction sites on the road because they drive themselves, that eliminates the need for extra transport vehicles. Being able to travel on their own greatly reduces transport expenses at the end of the day. The truck crane on the other hand is not stable enough to handle all the major loads which a hydraulic crane could handle. Therefore, to be able to fix this issue, outriggers can be extended from the deck. The outriggers use hydraulic pressure in order to slightly lift the truck off of the ground, making it balanced and stable. The crawler crane is unique in that it has large tracks on the bottom of the crane. These massive tracks are very similar to bulldozers and backhoes. The tracks enable the crane to move around a construction site successfully.
